

RAILROAD BRIDGE 10K INSTRUCTIONS

VIRTUAL RACE COURSE

Larry Scott Trail 10K Course is all marked and ready for VIRTUAL participants!

Note you do not have to participant on the same course in order to complete the VIRTUAL LARRY SCOTT TRAIL RUN. It is just set up for people who would like to run the actual course.

The race course is as follows:

*****PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT A CLOSED COURSE. TRAFFIC HAS THE RIGHT OF WAY. ALWAYS LOOK BOTH WAYS FOR TRAFFIC BEFORE CROSSING ANY ROADS*****

The entire course is on the Olympic Discovery Trail. Follow the signs for the Olympic Discovery Trail.

10K COURSE -

- Start SOUTH (Towards the papermill) of the Parking area with the bathrooms (same starting line as 2019)



- Run SOUTH-WEST (towards Papermill) on the Olympic Discovery Trail.

- Cross over Thomas St. (VERY BUSY STREET WITH CARS / TRUCKS

COMING AROUND THE CORNER)

- Mile Marker 1 will be on your LEFT (just after Thomas St.)



- Continue on the trail. Cross over Mill Road. Be careful this is a busy road. The cars have the right of way. Be sure to look both ways before crossing.

-Mile 2 is on the right hand side of the trail south of the northern car barricade post at Highway 20 underpass.



-Go under the Highway 20 underpass.

- Mile 3 is on the right hand side of the trail.



- After the underpass continue on the trail it will turn right. You will go through a tunnel under South Discovery Bay Road.

- The 10K Turn around will be on the right hand side before you get to Nelsons Landing.



-Turn around and head back on the exact same course. Go through the tunnel.

- Mile 4 will be on the right hand side of the trail.



- Continue on the trail. Cross over Mill Street. Be sure to look both ways before crossing the street.

- Mile 5 will be on your right before Thomas St.



- Cross over Thomas St. (VERY BUSY STREET WITH CARS / TRUCKS COMING AROUND THE CORNER)

- Mile 6 will be on your left on a shared post.



**-The FINISH Line is the Same as the Starting line!! Congratulations!
